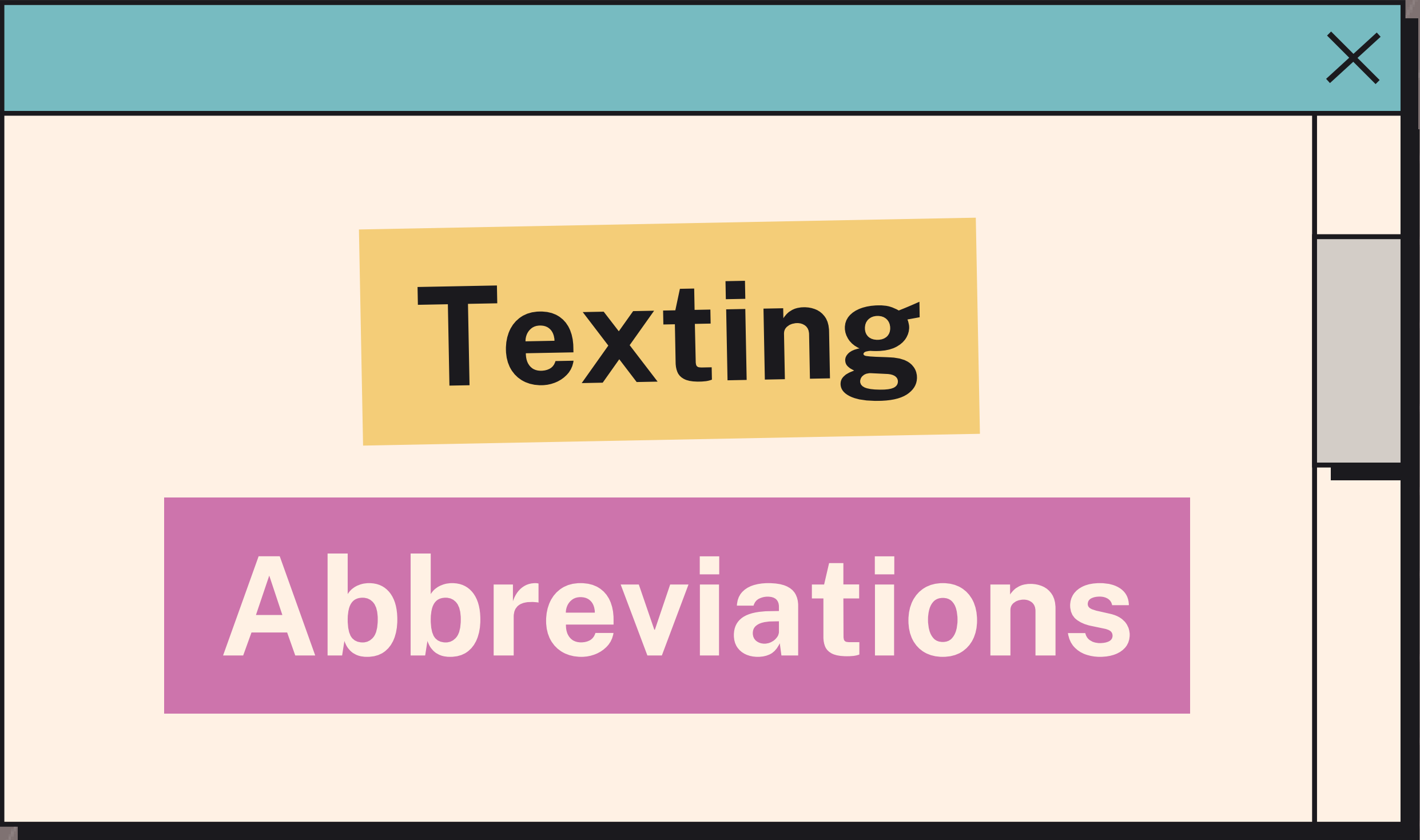


YOU DO NEED A PHONE CONTRACT

To send a text message from your phone, you need a sim card and a payment plan - either Pay as You Go or a monthly contract!

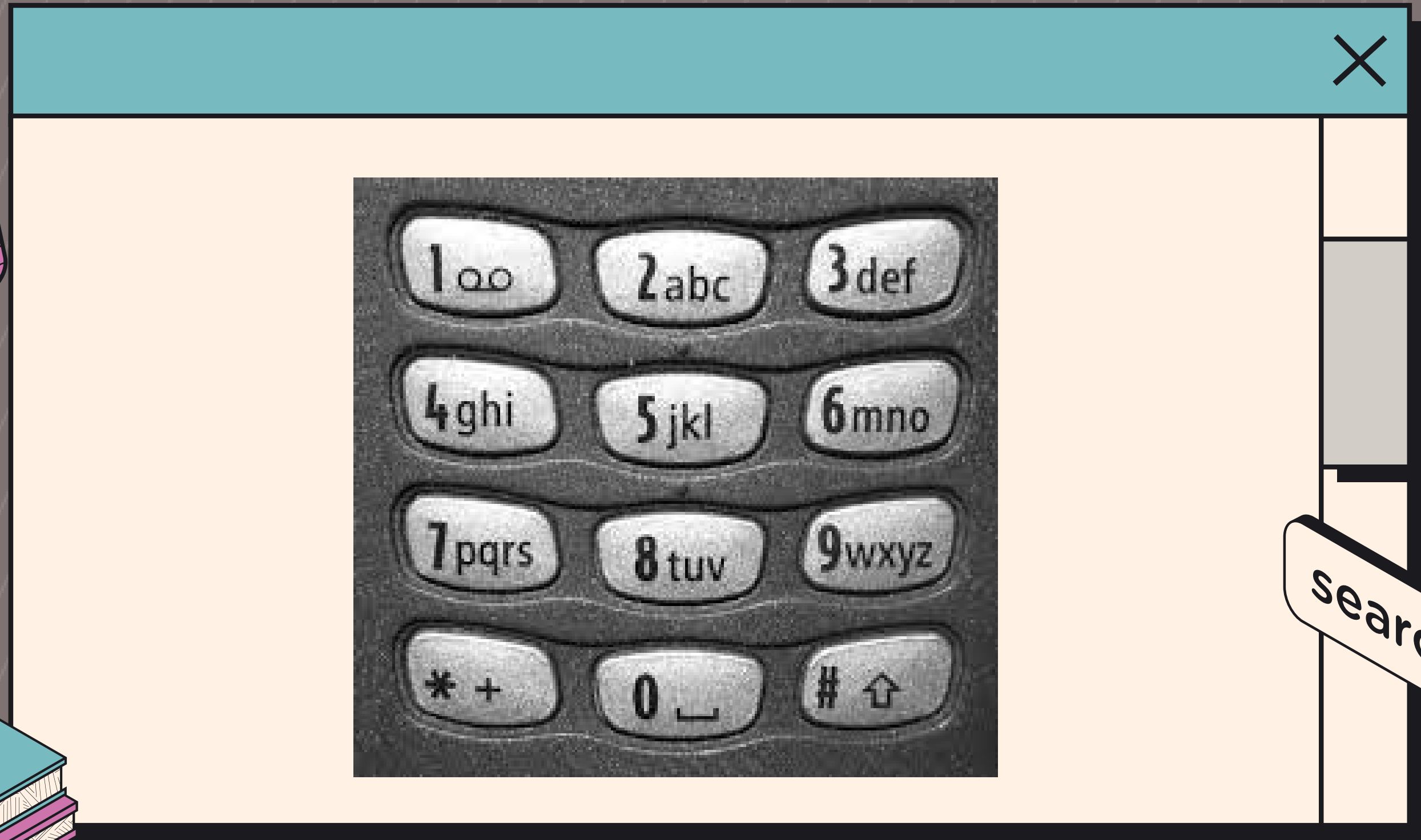
YOU DON'T EVEN HAVE TO TYPE!

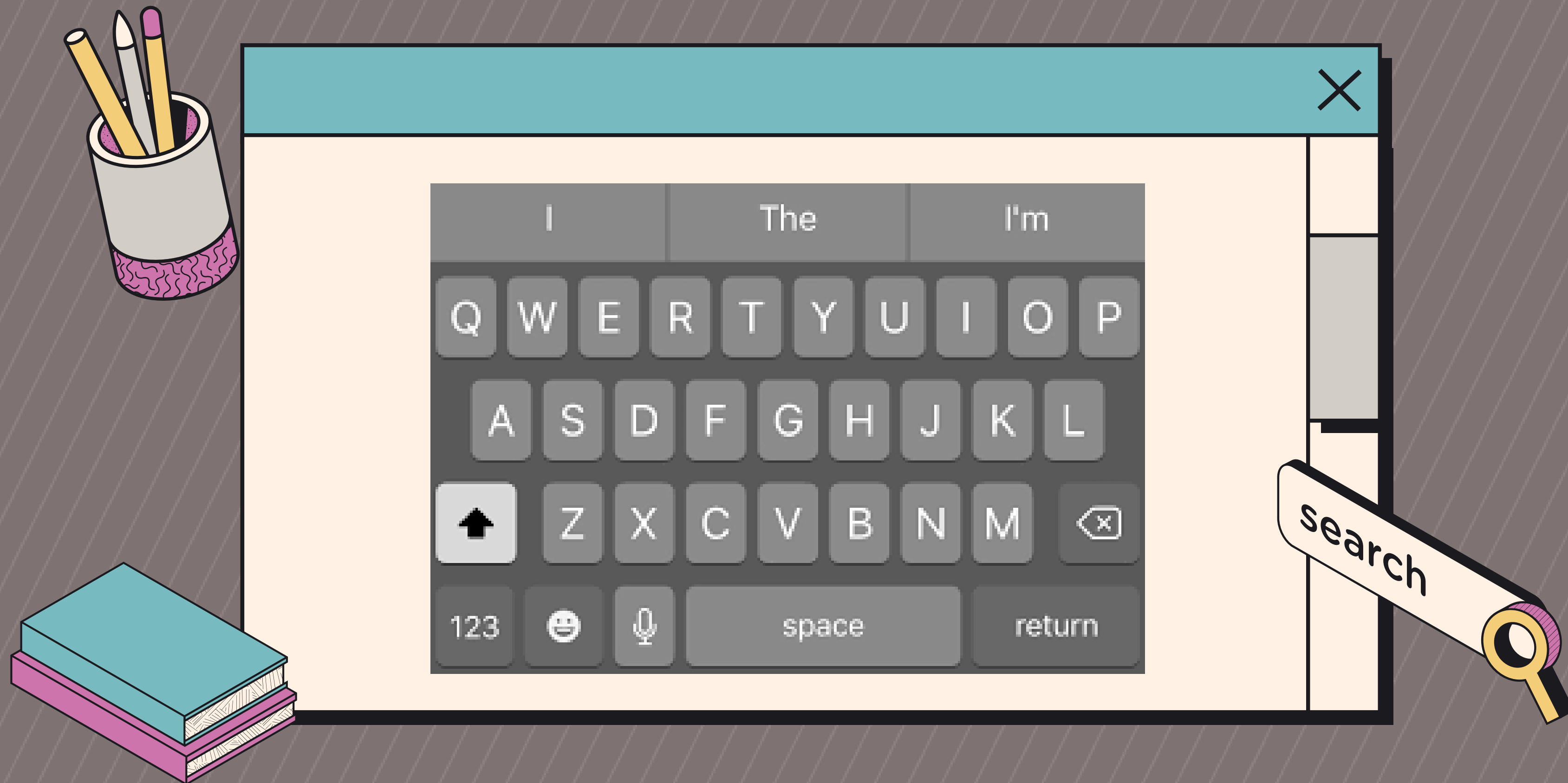
Most newer phones have options to instead send voice messages, or an option to dictate texts by speaking!

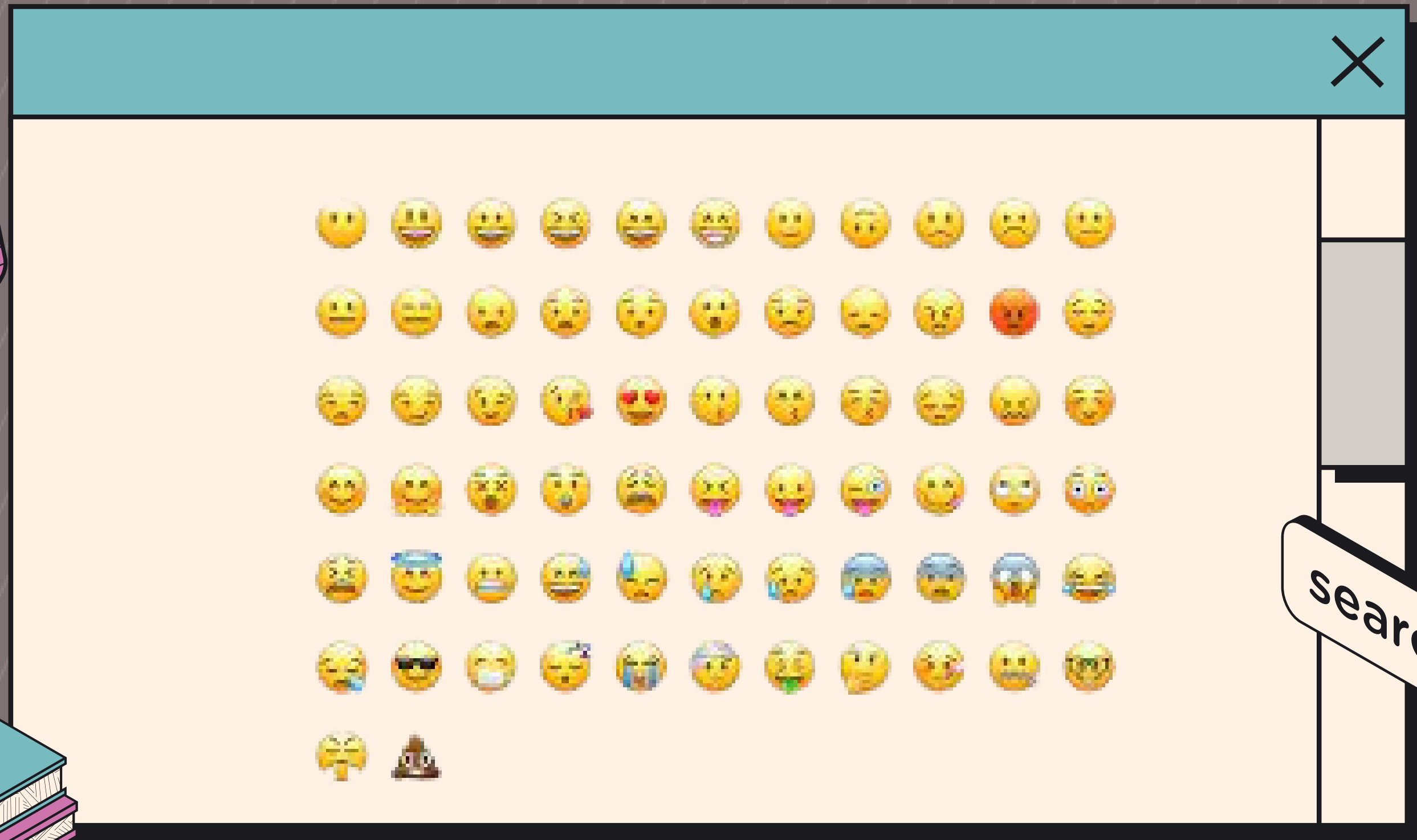

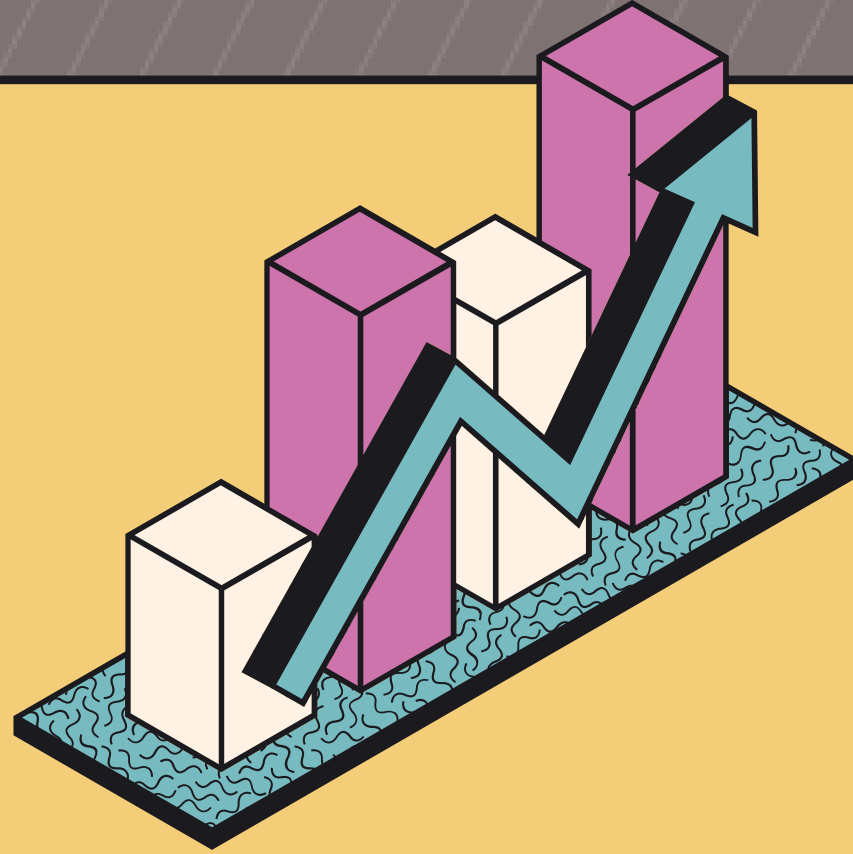

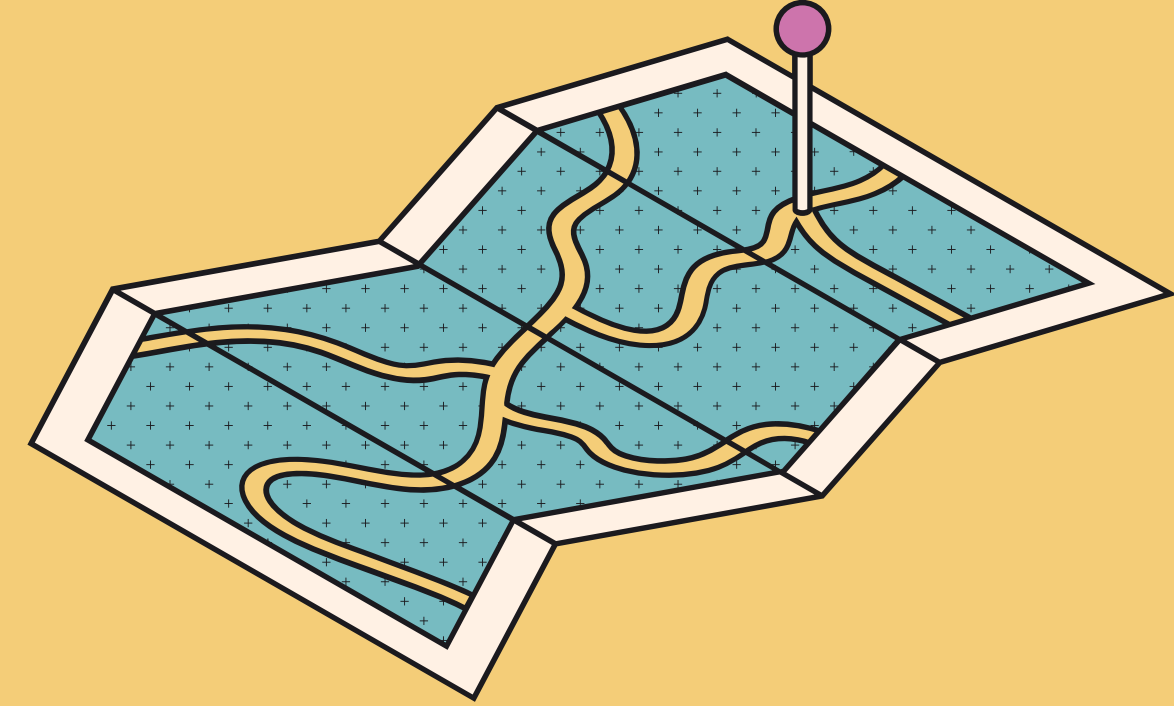
Social Media is a good option to communicate - and it is mostly free! You can even make free phone and video calls across the globe.

Emails

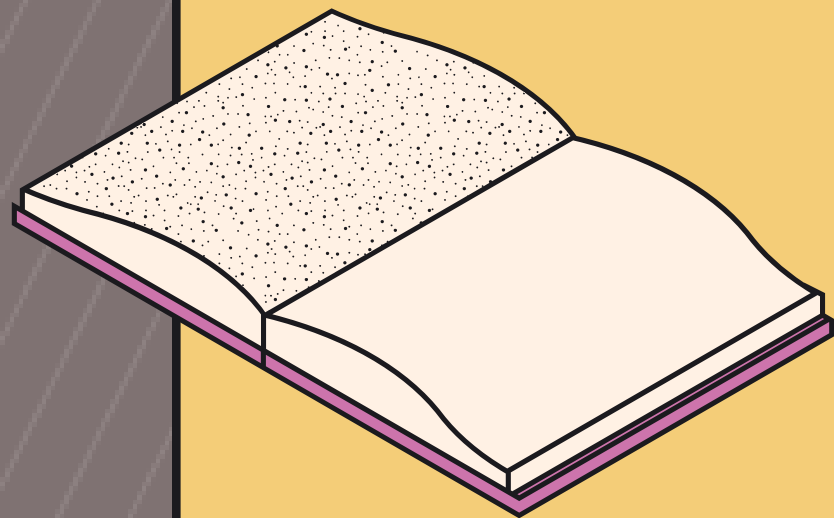
YOU NEED ONE!
